	A candidate or political committee is inactive if the candidate or committee:	
1.	Has never filed or has ceased to file reports under Election Code Chapter 254;	
2.	In the case of a candidate, has not been elected to an office for which a candidate is required to file a campaign treasurer appointment with the Board; and	
3.	Has not filed a final report under Election Code 254.065 or 254.125, or a dissolution report under Election Code 254.126 or 254.159.	
trea	Before the secretary of the District may terminate a campaign treasurer appointment, the Board must consider the proposed termination in a regularly scheduled open meeting. The termination of a campaign treasurer appointment under this section takes effect on the 30th day after the date of the meeting at which the Board votes to terminate the appointment. Following that meeting, the secretary of the District shall promptly notify the affected candidate or political committee that the appointment has been terminated.
